A candidate can apply in any ONE of the categories
Exam Fellowship / Non-Exam Fellowship

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

IAGES Membership is a must. Those who are not members may apply for membership online. See the website www.iages.in for more details.

Post graduate degree in surgery is mandatory.

A resident or junior consultant should obtain a certificate of experience from the HOD of the hospital/Institution as a supportive document. Attach soft copies of the MBBS, MS, or DNB certificate and MCI/ State registration certificate during membership registration.

Candidates also have to register for the Conference to be held in Thane from June 12th to 14th, 2026 in order to attend Live Surgeries, Lectures and Convocation Ceremony.

1. Non - Examination Category

Surgeons who have been doing Laparoscopy / Robotic surgery for 10 or more years are eligible for Non Examination Category. Candidates should have performed atleast 100 laparoscopic / robotic surgeries and need to submit logbook to substantiate claim. All the candidates will be interviewed by the IAGES board for final assessment before the award of fellowship.

2. Examination Category

All surgeons with a minimum of 3 years experience Post MS/DNB in Laparoscopy / Robotic Surgery. The applicant should have Either assisted or performed 25 surgeries robotically. All the candidates would appear for MCQ assessment and Viva by the IAGES FALS board for final assessment before awarding the fellowship.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Suggested Reading:

Any textbooks/ journals pertaining to Advanced Laparoscopic & Robotic Surgery. Onsite Module: Will include Lectures/ Panel discussions/ Live operative workshop & exams / viva on 12th to 14th , June 2026.

MCQ Exam:

Time: 60 minutes (Maximum number of marks: 100) The exam will have 100 MCQ questions (single best response type) and will be conducted via an online link. The candidate has to be present at the venue in person.

Practical Examination:

Interview/assessment for approximately 10 minutes on each candidate. The candidates will be divided in to batches and interviewed by senior faculty members of IAGES depending upon the number of candidates. Maximum of 50 marks are allotted for the interview.

Result:

Outcome of written and practical assessment will be prepared by the organizing team and to be signed and to be sent to the President with a copy to Hon Secretary Office and FALS board and results will be published in the IAGES website. Candidates will have to register and attend the upcoming IAGES Annual conference scheduled in February 2027 at New Delhi, India in order to receive the fellowship certificate.

Assessment of FALS Robotics fellowship candidates will be conducted by IAGES Central Office.
